Key findings

1. Homework has a positive impact on average (+ 5 months), particularly with pupils in secondary schools.

What you can expect from homework at St Joseph's

- Homework will be set on E-praise. Students will be given more than 24 hours to complete homework.
- Each subject will set 2 homeworks per fortnight with the occasional additional learning or research homework to supplement this. This may not always be on the same day each week as it is important that homework set is relevant to the learning.

The exceptions to this rule are:

- Subjects that require Coursework and significant amounts of practical work. Homework will vary in frequency throughout the year due to the strict rules about what work can and can't be taken home. (I-media, sports science, Health & Social, Food tech, Arts Award)
- Physical Education - all students are encouraged to take part in extra-curricular sport/ fitness sessions. The expectation is that every child does at least one bucket list activity per week.
