PLEASE TAKE CARE ON OUR CAR PARK!

All people travelling to school by car should use our church car park, entering via the church drive and leaving behind the parish centre as all the 'one way' signs instruct. Please take note of all road markings, especially the 'give way' lines. Cedar Road is to be used as our pedestrian entrance only, no one should be using Cedar Road or Willow Road to be dropping children off by car.

We are very lucky that we have such a big car park to use at drop off and pick up times, with overflow spaces also available around the back of the parish centre.

We have had numerous complaints since we have come back to school after the Summer Holidays about reckless driving. Please keep in mind that CHILDREN will be walking on the car park and adhere to the 10 mile an hour speed limit put in place.

REMINDER:

Earrings are strictly not permitted in school. We only allow children to wear plasters over their earrings if they are still healing. As we are now in our fourth week back after summer no one should need to be wearing their earrings unless a member of staff is told otherwise by a parent or carer.

We have this rule in place for the children's safety. Children can have bumps and falls on the playground, which can result in nasty injuries if they are wearing earrings.
