Expressive Arts and Design

- Capture and respond to experiences with a range of media and materials
- Improvise and invent songs
- Sing along with familiar nursery rhymes.

Communication & Language

- To be able to listen in small groups of up to 5 children (rising 3's)
- Understand 'who', 'what' and 'where' questions.
- Understand instructions with sequences, first, after, last.

Phonics

The children will be working in small groups to develop phase 1 phonics. Some of the targets they will be working on are repeated from last half term due to some sessions being missed.


Aspect 4 Rhythm and Rhyme

- To join in with words and phrases
- Move in time to the beat or rhythm
- Identify words that rhyme
- Recognise syllables in words.

We will then move onto Aspect 5 Alliteration.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- To show an interest in others feelings
- Understand turn taking with adults and peers
- To be able to make their own choices linked to their likes/dislikes
- To share resources with their friends, understanding that their needs cannot always be met (rising 3's).

Understanding of the World

- Talk about what is seen or happening using a range of subject specific vocabulary
- Generate and solve problems.
- Make predictions.

Physical Development

- Catch and throw a large ball
- Snip with scissors
- Develop more control when balancing on one leg
- Develop spatial awareness during play.

Maths

- Count forwards and backwards to 3/5
- Recognise that numbers in a set does not change if they are moved around
- Show awareness of numerals in the environment
- Represent numbers 1-5 on their fingers
- Say numbers to 10 in order
- Copy an AB pattern
- Match and compare quantities using the language 'fewer' and 'same'.
