

**An informal consultation about our proposal to
develop a special educational needs unit within
St Joseph's Catholic Primary School
Cedar Road, Chorley, PR6 0JF**

This is an informal consultation about making a prescribed alteration to a school in accordance with The School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013.



We are seeking your initial views about a proposal to create a special educational needs (SEN) unit within St Joseph's Catholic Primary School.

We want to assure you that we will give careful consideration to all your comments and opinions. We will use your feedback to develop our proposal ready to take to the next stage of formal consultation.

This is a legal requirement in order to make changes like this to a school.

What are we planning to do?

The proposal is to create an SEN unit for up to sixteen children with social communication and interaction needs in St Joseph's Catholic Primary School.

All of these children will have education, health and care plans. Some of these children will transfer from another school to St Joseph's Catholic Primary School so that they can attend the SEN unit.

Children attending the SEN unit may be taught in the unit for some of the time and at other times when appropriate they will be taught with other children in existing classes.

All children already on roll at St Joseph's Catholic Primary School will still be able to attend the school and this change will not affect current admission criteria and numbers.

Why are we doing this?

To give families more choice about the type of school they would like their child to attend.

To make sure there is specialist support for all children with special educational needs.

Existing pupils, whether or not they have special educational needs, will benefit from the specialist knowledge of staff working with children in the SEN unit leading to an overall enhancement in the quality of teaching throughout the school.

There is a particular need for SEN units in the Lancashire South area.

What will happen next?

Careful consideration will be given to all responses that are received on or before 26 May 2024.

These responses will be used to inform us how to develop this proposal, ready for a formal consultation that is needed to make a change like this to a school.

We would like your views on this proposal to create an SEN unit at St Joseph's Catholic Primary School. An event will be held during the informal consultation period so that you can get more information and ask any questions you may have. Details about this will be available on the school website.
