
#### Yarrow Recommends!

### New to the class library



And then she finds a strange coded note which seems to link Sukie to Devon, and to something dark and impossibly dangerous. A gripping adventure!

My must-read book of this half term is **The Light Jar** by **Lisa Thompson**, which tells the story of Nate and his mother who are running away, hiding out in a
