 This creates gaps in their knowledge and could mean they will not meet their full potential

85%	=	143 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 28.5 days or 5 weeks & 2.5 days of learning missed
80%	=	190 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 38 days or 7 weeks & 2 days of learning missed
