Key skills	Maths Focus on your number formation and making sure your numbers are facing the correct way	Reading Daily Read your home readers. Discuss what you have read and ask an adult to sign your reading record.	Writing Remember to use capital letters and full stops correctly in any writing you do. Make sure any sentences you have written make sense!	Spelling Remember to use your phonics to sound out tricky words
Topic- Continents and Oceans/Living things and their habitats	Create a food chain for an animal. Think about where the animal may sit in the chain and what else is surrounding them	<u>Where in the world have you been?</u> Tell me about a country you have visited or would like to visit.	Create a poster that shows Noah and his ark and explain why the animals all went aboard	Design a microhabitat for an animal of your choice, include food sources and areas to keep them safe
	Carry out research of one of the seven continents. You can present it in a booklet, poster, factfile	Draw a map of the world and identify the seven continents and 5 oceans	Using part whole models, show as many ways as possible you can make 100	Write an independent story about an animal and their habit. Remember to use capital letters, finger spaces, nouns and adjectives

Label it and tell me why you might take these things.	Draw and label a person from a hot climate and a cold climate and compare the two.
