Writing When you have finished your reading book, write a short review that is 50 words long in your diary. Remember to check punctuation.	Spelling Each week, look at your spellings a few times. Discuss what the words mean if you aren't sure; try to spell them without looking.	Maths Practise the 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12 times tables. You can use Sumdog or TT Rockstars to play games.
Tasks linked to learning in school: Our Wonderful World	Science Take a walk at the park. Make a list of the different animals you see. Can you find any mammals, birds or insects?	Science Identify what an endangered species are. Can you find any examples of endangered species around the world?	Science Choose an animal e.g. a frog. Make a model of its habitat inside a shoebox or draw a picture.	R.E. Who was John the Baptist?
	Geography Can you find out some of the largest volcanoes on Earth? You could write about them or draw them on a map.	Geography Make a model of a volcano from old junk or using papier-mâché.	R.E. Who was Elijah?	Design Technology Take a walk or bike ride along the promenade to see Blackpool illuminations. Then design one of your own.
	Spanish Think about the 'family' vocabulary you are learning. Make a picture of your family; label them with the words you learn.	Music Practise your cornet at least three times per week so you succeed in your Friday lessons.	Art Practise drawing animals realistically by looking at photos. Try to get their shapes and details accurate.	Art Draw some simple objects at home such an apple. Can you try to show where the shadows are by shading with your pencil?
