Learning Support	Class Teacher employed to support Covid interventions (21 PP chn)	£15,000 Catch up funding	Teacher 0.6 recruited in September to accelerate learning due to gaps widened with Covid lockdown with Yr 3, 4 and 5 – (21 PP children) Assessments at the start of school year show children are showing significant gaps in learning – Recent assessments show children are making progress but all behind age related expectations – These interventions will continue in Spring 2021 and impact will be closely monitored.
	Small group support – Teacher Led	£19,985	PP children in Yr 6 have targeted support 3 days weekly in Maths and English Small sessions allows more direct and personal teaching to provide the support and scaffolding need to progress the group. Rec/Y1/Y2 Catch up 1:1 and small group teaching incl PP with CMc and CMu
	Third Space Learning (5chn incl 2PP/1LAC)	£500	5 PP children from Year 6 are having personalised online maths 1:1 intervention weekly to accelerate their progress
	IDL spelling programme	£200	Whole school intervention was promoted and utilised during home learning opportunities during lockdown IDL programme supporting PP children in school with daily 15 min sessions. Pupil are progressing at a rapid rate to bridge gaps.
	Rockstars Times tables	£95	Progress of timetables- Teachers reporting this is improving accuracy across the school and filling gaps due to Covid 19 – Children are recapping on previous learning in response to missed learning
	Healthy Heads Yrs 1-6 2 classes per term for 5x1hr sessions	£1,200	Whole class mental health sessions to support anxiety and positive well being
	Communicate Speech Therapy (11PP chn)	£5,500	3 days assessments in school by trained therapist for children including 11 PP children and chn showing a decline in communication due to lockdown– New targets set and discussed with TA/CMu and relevant staff. 1-1 speech and language daily has had an impact on 70% of children meeting their targets for this term
	Talkboost (9 PPchn)	£1,500	Many children during lockdown including PP/EAL children have not had quality access to communication. Talk boost provides 3 x weekly intervention sessions to support PP children (9 PP children in Aut 2). Sessions started in Aut 2 – impact will be accessed in 10 weeks and will continue with other PP and EAL children in Spring
	SEN interventions – Better Reading, ECAR, Talkboost	£4,200	Intensive catch up interventions are being implemented in Bubble groups

Pastoral Support	Therapy Dog to support learning and pastoral care	£2,300	Therapy Dog is allowing children to opportunity to read and communicate at all levels – Children have used Marley when they have been anxious, this has allowed chn to share their feelings and worries. SEN/PP children have been reading with the dog and staff have used him to help in speech and language sessions One pupil (Rec) spoke for the first time in a whole sentence to Marley!
	Family Support	£7,386	The family support worker has supported 12 PP families during lockdown with Mungo Meals programme. This is ongoing throughout Autumn 1 term – funding will allow this to continue in Spring term. Home visits to vulnerable families providing emotional support and finical support. 1-1 support for positive mental health sessions with learning mentor– 10 children have engaged and seeked support this term – Chn are responding to sessions – this is ongoing daily for the needs of all children
