Clear evidence of the impact of confidence levels growing in children’s own abilities which is impacting on whole class academic learning – Spring assessments will show impact and give data to reassess targets for children. 	Small group support – Teacher Led (21PP)	£18,450	16 PP children in Rec, Y1 and Y2 have targeted support weekly in Maths and English Small sessions allows more direct and personal teaching to provide the support and scaffolding need to progress the group.
	Third Space Learning (20 PPchn)	£2,950	20 PP children from Y5 and Y6 have tutored 1-1 support weekly to accelerate their progress maths interventions. Teachers have expressed there is evidence of progress in Autumn 1 data and will be assessed in Spring 2
	IDL spelling programme	£238	IDL is being used both in school targeting children through the school day. Log in details are still shared with parents and the program is encouraged for use at home. Children's most recent spelling ages tested in school show progress. The most recent spelling ages show SEN and Pupil Premium groups who are frequent in school users of IDL are making sustained progress.
	Rockstars Times tables	£596.16	Progress of timetables- Teachers reporting this is improving accuracy across the school and filling gaps due to Covid 19 – Children are recapping on previous learning in response to missed learning

PP pupils have had 1-1 and group sessions around many issues and Marley has been used in these sessions to support children's emotions, including social skills to bereavement counselling.
