Hands-On Experience

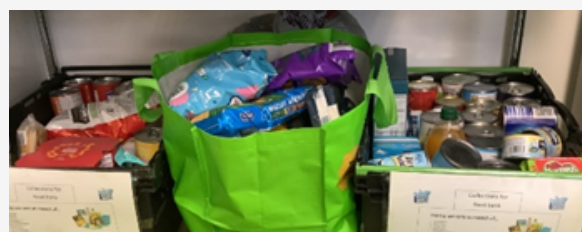
Students rolled up their sleeves to pick and pack food donations, creating food parcels for local families. They developed practical skills in organisation, teamwork, and collaboration throughout the day.
