Come and take part in a play about the Christmas story dressed as your favourite nativity character!

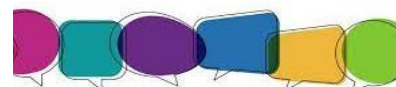
21 Christmas Fun Day
