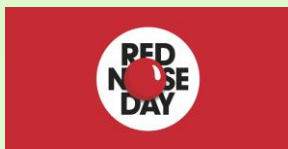

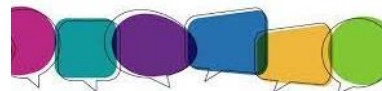
## After School Clubs
