Our New After School Clubs are now available up until Thursday 9th February. All Clubs are Free of charge.

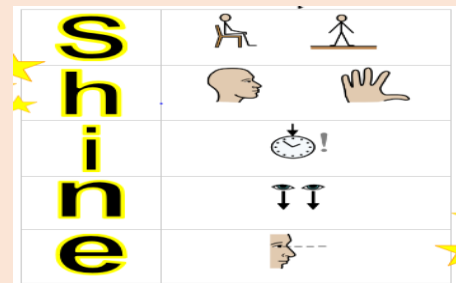
