7th March – World Book Day, dress as a book character

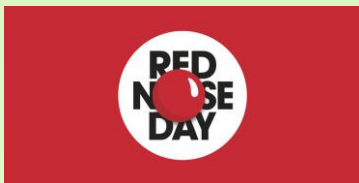


14th March - Planting afternoon

After School Clubs

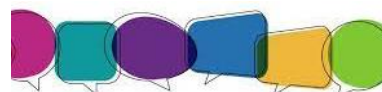
Please see below our after school clubs, they are free of charge
