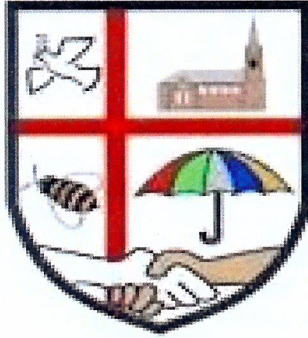

## New to you

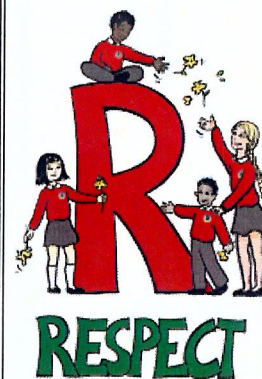
We have lots of new to you uniform in school of all different sizes, if you need anything please call in on any Friday after the assembly. All we ask is small donation for each item.
