If you require any help please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

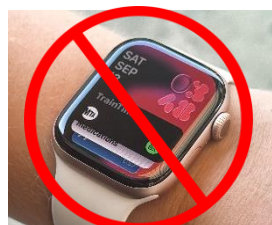


Uniform
