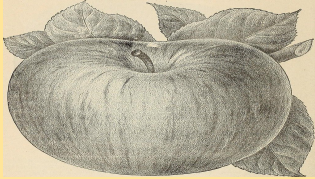


Year 6 Spring Term Homework
