## Maths shape hunt (Maths)

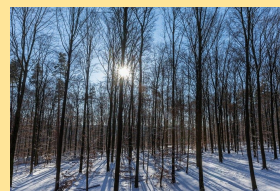
Go on a walk or search around the house for different shapes.

Now that it's getting cold, and we are growing up, it is time that we can zip our coats, use a knife and fork and get ourselves dressed.

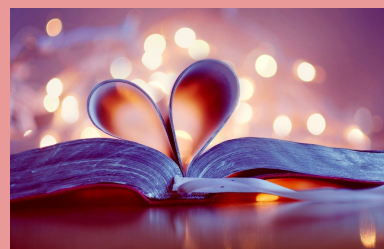
Practise these skills, every day. We might need some help to begin with, but we need to be able to do these things **independently!** (on our own!)
