Dear Parents,

We would like to start by saying how proud we are of the children for how they conducted themselves during SATs week. They have all worked extremely hard and showed great courage, resilience and determination in completing the Key Stage 2 assessments. Well done!

We have outlined below the final half term in Year 6.

Transition to Year 7

There will be a focus on transition to secondary school this term. You should have received relevant information from your child's chosen secondary school regarding important dates. There will be a transition day on **Friday 4th July** for those children going to Durham Johnston. We will also be focusing on 'Moving On' and 'Transition' during our PSHE sessions.

Enterprise Project

Children will be taking part in the Virgin Money 'Make £5 Grow' enterprise to gain experience of running their own businesses. They will have the opportunity to showcase their business ventures during the school's Summer Fayre on **Saturday 28**th **June**.

Topics to be completed this half term:

English: This term we will be reading the class novel 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo. We will be looking at the text features of this novel but also will explore: characters and settings, effective vocabulary and grammar choices.

Maths: This term, children will have the opportunity to consolidate their prior learning and recap key knowledge and skills designed to support with their transition to secondary school. There will also be a focus upon allowing children to apply their learning from the Year 6 curriculum to help them to investigate and solve problems.

Science - Living things and their Habitats

Geography- Fantastic Forests. We will be exploring the vegetation in the local area as part of this unit and will be looking at the different types of forest around the world.

Computing – Programming Micro:bits

Art – Textiles based on the artist Henri Rousseau and art work based on the Japanese artist Hokusai.

DT – As part of cooking and nutrition, we will be designing and making pizza.

RE – 'What do we now know about Christianity?'

French – The units will be about 'Habitats' and 'Me in the World'.

PSHCE – This term in PSHE our topic is 'Living in the Wider World'. We will begin by learning about the responsibilities which come with owning a mobile phone before moving on to critically examining the information which is presented to us in the media and on social media. We will then look at the UK political system and democracy in general before finishing off the term by considering our aspirations for the future. This term we will also work with local secondary schools on transition. The school nurse will be working with us on puberty and basic human reproduction.
