To the ends of the earth:

Identify that scripture speaks of the outpouring of gifts of the Holy Spirit on the Messiah in the Old Testament and the gospels.

Using the lives of Mary and another saint as examples, explain what the term 'discipleship' means.

Describe the names and signs under which the Holy Spirit appears and explain some simple links with scripture and the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Know that the Rosary is a prayerful reflection on the life of Christ and explain what the glorious mysteries remember.

Saying what they wonder about the Holy Spirit in the life of Jesus and mystery of the Holy Trinity.

Expressing and explaining a preference for an artistic representation of the Holy Spirit

Consider the claim 'the Sacrament of Confirmation helps a Christian grow in virtue', expressing a point of view about this statement.
