

 - He is very funny and calls Giles 'Piles'.
 - He is kind to Tim and gives him a tissue and a biscuit.
 - He is a good friend to Tim.



- He is very posh and has lots of expensive equipment.
- He is unkind to Tim and makes fun of him.
- He is very competitive and wants to win everything.


