


During the rest of this week we are going to plan and then write our own diary entry from Tim's point of view.


Today: Collect useful words and phrases from diary texts.






Task 1:


TUESDAY

There sat the Princess, tap, tap, tap, and there was me, bored out of my skull.


To be fair, the Princess does always walk me first thing in the morning. But this particular morning, I was in disgrace for bouncing.

So I was firmly put back on my lead.




