Skara Brae is on one of the Orkney Islands off the North coast of Scotland.




# Revision: The Stone Age - Time Periods



### Skara Brae - Extra Facts

- Located in Orkney, an island to the North of Scotland
- Late Neolithic Settlement
- People lived there between 3200 and 2200BCE.
- · 8 houses have been found at Skara Brae.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> of the houses were found because of a storm in 1850 which destroyed 'sand dunes' and revealed houses.
- 7 of the 8 houses all have the same layout.
- Skara Brae is now a World Heritage Site.
