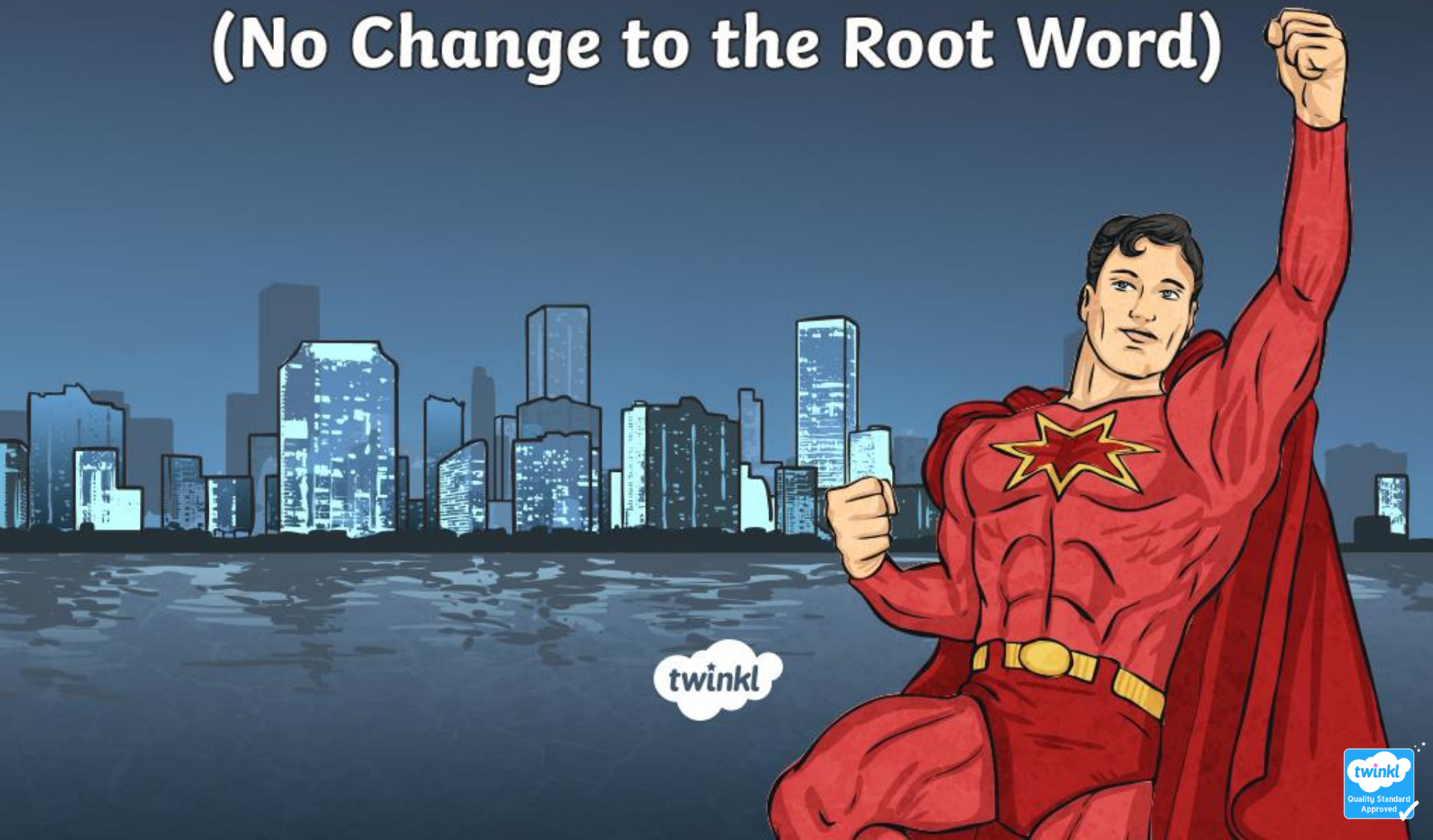


Creating Adverbs Using the Suffix -ly (No Change to the Root Word)

Adverbs are often formed when the suffix -ly is added to an adjective root word. Look what happens here...

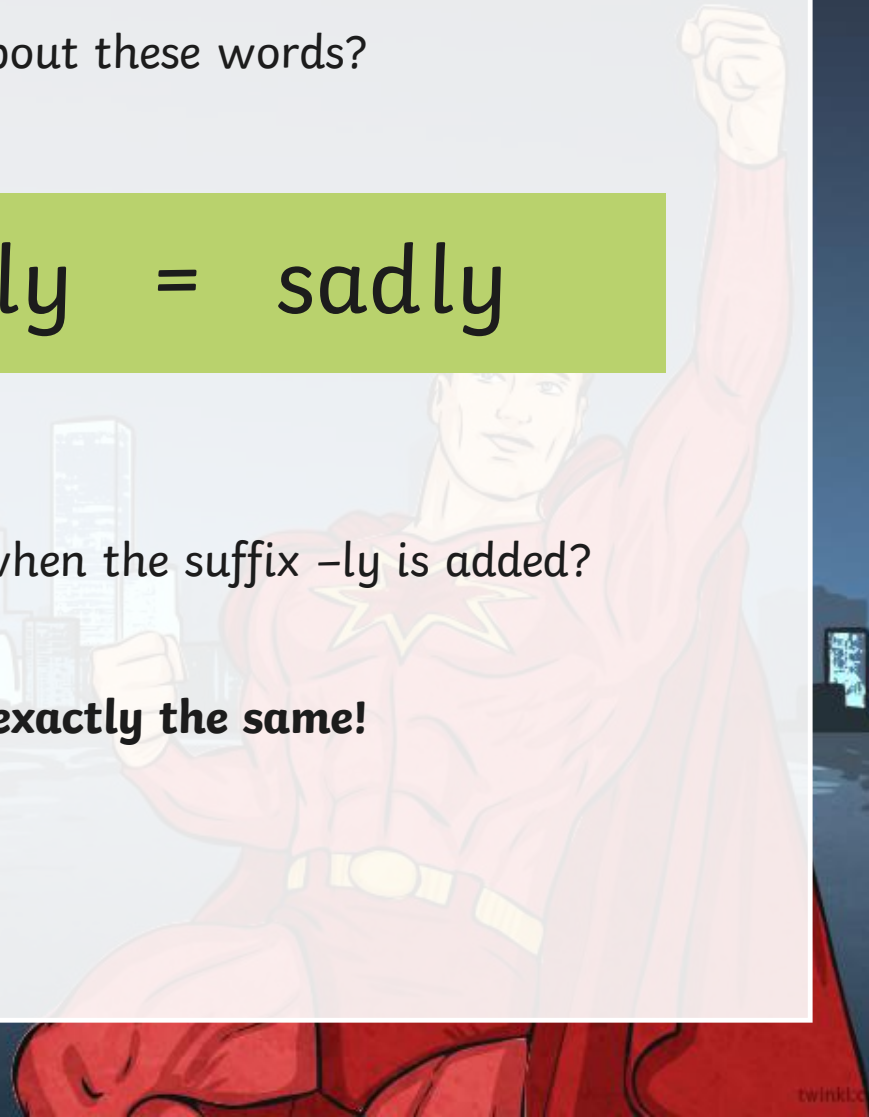
What do you notice about these words?
