


### This week we are looking at how to create **adverbs** using the suffix -ly...

## Adverbs are often formed when the suffix -ly is added to an adjective root word. Look what happens here...

What do you notice about these words?



sad + ly = sadly

How does the root word change when the suffix -ly is added?

It doesn't! It remains exactly the same!
