To Practise writing our names! Each child has come home with a name card- please encourage your child to practise writing their names, taking care to use a capital letter at the start and forming the letters correctly. Children should not be using capital letters to write the whole of their name- only a capital letter for the first letter of their name. We'd love to see photos of the children practising their name on dojo- you could get creative- make their name out of playdough or use their finger to write their name in flour tipped in a tray.

What we are learning....

This week we have been continuing getting used to our classroom routines and learning about our school rules- Is it my best? Is it caring? And is it safe?

We have made some subitising cards using stickers to show 1, 2 or 3. We have been counting lots! Counting 5 objects- talking about how we should count slowly, and we can move the objects into a line to help us to count- saying one number name for each object. We even counted noises! I banged my drum and the children had to count in their head how many I had done, then they all had a turn.

We have been practising writing our names the correct way. Children will come home with their own name card, to practise writing their names. A capital letter should be at the start, and lower case letters after.

We had our first PE lesson! Our focus was mainly on getting changed and looking after our belongings- which can be tricky at the start of school! We got chance to have a great PE lesson. The children were fantastic! Please continue to encourage independence with getting changed at home. Thank you!
