What we are learning....

Wow! The children have wowed us with their phonics learning this week! We have learnt 3 sounds 'm', 'd', and 'g'. The children are doing great at recognising these sounds and practising writing the sounds with the correct letter formation. Keep practising at home!

In our maths we have been looking at the number 3. We had a 3 bears picnic, where we had to share out 3 plates, spoons, forks and cartons of milk. We have been using the stem sentence "1 and another 1 and another 1 is 3". You might want to practise this at home when you see 3 objects.

We had a visit from Mrs Charnley who shared with us the story of creation. The children sat beautifully and enjoyed the bible story. Mrs Charnley will join us each week to share a story from the bible with us.
