# Home Learning

Each week we will give you some home learning for your child to do at home. This will be something linked to what we are working on at school and will cover a range of skills over the year. Or you can send it in as a message- we love to share these moments with the class

This week, your child's home learning is to practise getting dressed independently.

Wow! What a great first full week we have had! The children have really amazed us with their confidence and happiness in the classroom. They are getting used to the routines and we are already well on our way with our learning!

We will start our PE sessions next week. Please ensure children have a full PE kit in school with black pumps/plimsolls. Please encourage your child, over the next few weeks to get changed independently. We are happy to help the children if they are struggling, but it makes it so much easier if they can begin changing independently.

## Reminders

All children's items of clothing, coats bags and water bottles should be clearly labelled with their name. It makes things much easier to find the owner when things are left in the classroom at the end of the day and saves us a lot of time. Thank you for your support!

We will start PE next Thursday- please ensure children have a PE kit in school; again all items named- it is amazing what can get lost when a class full of children get changed for PE. Children should have black pumps and shorts and the t-shirt provided at the settling in sessions

Children should not be wearing any jewelry to school- no earrings please.

## What we are learning....

This week we have been getting used to the routines, and exploring the classroom. We are getting to know each other, and getting bet-

ter at remembering everyone's names. We have been talking about our feelings through the story 'The Colour Monster'.

We began phonics, learning our first few sounds. Please ensure children are practising their sounds at home. We have started our maths learning,

where we have been subitising- this is a very important skill where children look at small amounts of objects and are able to say how many are there without counting. We have been subitising looking at 1, 2 and 3 dots.

We also began our Reception Baseline Assessments. These are a government assessment which is carried our with reception age children.
