## <u>Information on the changes of the self-isolation period</u>

As you all aware the new 'Omicron Variant of Covid' is highly transmissible but not as severe. Unfortunately, I tested positive last weekend for the second time but haven't been anywhere as ill as the first time (thank goodness!) and hopefully only a few staff have been affected. We currently have 6 children who have also tested positive. Thank you to everyone for pulling together and helping out. Staff are still testing regularly and have been encouraged to make sure they are fully vaccinated including their booster so that they are not having additional time away from school. Please test your children if they have any symptoms.

The current isolation rules states that if you are fully vaccinated and test negative on days 6 and 7 then you can finish isolating and don't need to complete the full 10 days however, these are changing on Monday  $17^{th}$  January.

If you test positive on LFT there's no need to book a PCR. You must isolate immediately but can leave isolation after a negative LFT on days 5 and the morning of day 6. School will ask for evidence. Thank you!

#### Parking

Sorry to have to put this on again, however, I have been contacted by a member of the LCC waste disposal team who has informed me that for the second time in a week, the bin lorry was unable to gain access to the school because of parked cars outside the gates.
