#### P.E Bags

If your child's P.E Kit is still in school, please drop the office a message to arrange to collect. Free School Meals

All parents of children who are eligible for free school meals i.e.: in receipt of benefits (not Universal Free School Meals for Reception - Year 2 children) will receive a food parcel whilst schools are closed.

The parcel is for 1 child for 5 days which will be delivered to school on Tuesday and available to collect from the school entrance between 12pm to 3pm.

# Please contact the office before Friday 15th 12pm if you wish to order yours.

Whilst the Edenred system is not currently set up to support term time ordering of vouchers, this is something that the DfE are urgently working on. We are hoping over the next few weeks that we can continue to provide vouchers for those eligible pupils who will not be attending school during lockdown.

All children in R/Y1/Y2 attending school will be provided with a school packed lunch if required

All KS2 children attending school will need to bring a packed lunch from home.

Just a reminder that if you are in any doubt whether you may now be entitled to free school meals for your child, please contact Pupil Access Team at Lancashire County Council on 01772 531809 with your Name, Date of Birth and National Insurance Number.

You may be able to receive a weekly free school meal voucher for £15.00 (£60.00 per month per child/ £120.00 per month for 2 children and £180.00 per month for 3 children). The vouchers are to be spent at your chosen supermarket. It is definitely worth trying to see if you are eligible Qualifying benefits:

If you or your partner receive any of the following benefits you can apply for free school meals.

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- $\bullet$  Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit Universal Credit

Toast/fruit will be given to all children in school free of charge

### Reminder

School starts at 9am so the gates will not be open until 8:45am. Please do not send your children before this time. The gates will re-open at 2:40pm to collect your child promptly at 2:45pm Uniform must be washed daily to minimise the spreading of germs so your child may wear jogging bottoms/leggings and trainers for school as long as they wear a logo t-shirt, jumper or hoody. The boxes are ready for any reading books that need changing.
