St Maria Goretti's life is an example of purity and mercy. She is the patron saint of youth as she is the youngest saint. Maria died a tragic death at only 11 years old when she was brutally attacked and stabbed 14 times. Maria forgave her male attacker before she died. Maria then appeared to her attacker in prison and he described this visit as a lady in white who was gathering Lillies. That is why we have the 'Lily' as the flower of our school.
