We are going to concentrate on the prefix...

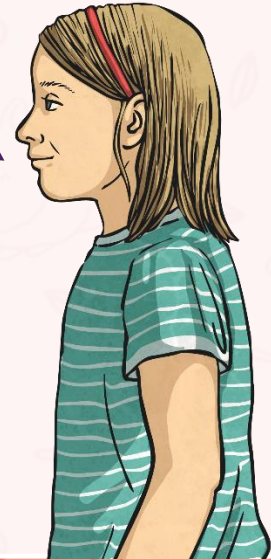
re-

Could you use each word in a sentence?

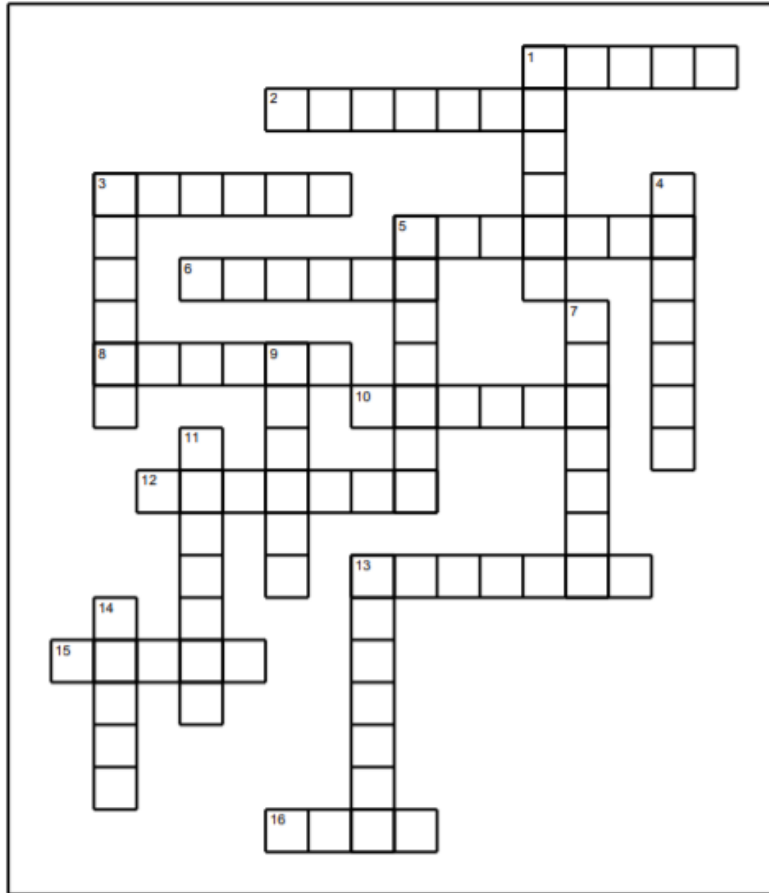

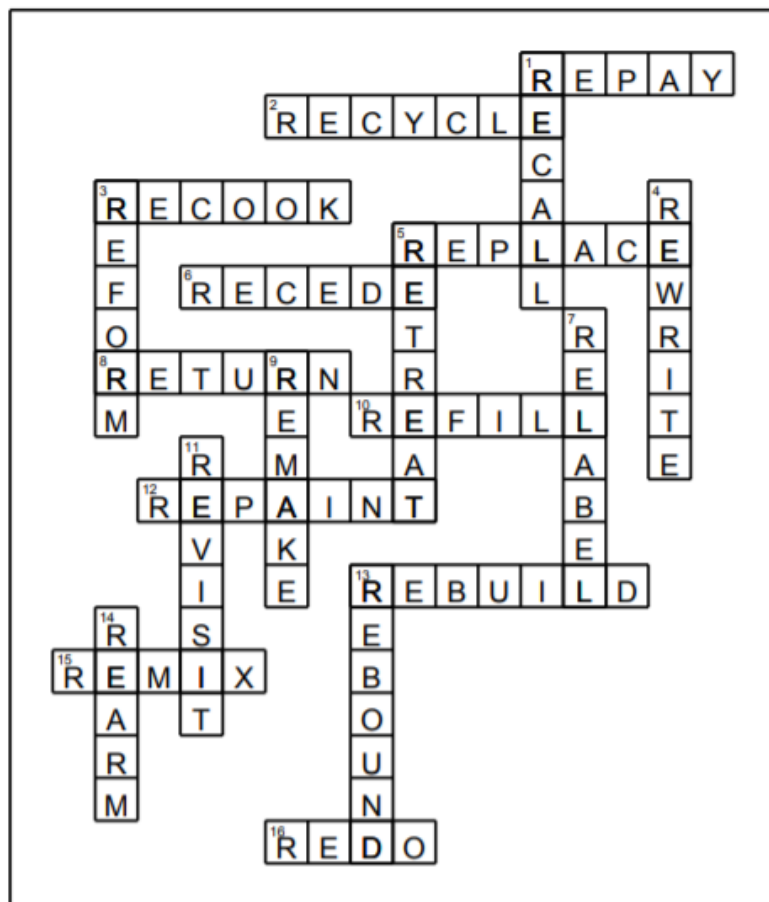
