- 11 Integrate daily physical activity into classroom routines throughout the school
- 12 To introduce a shared PE/School system so progress and attainment can be tracked
- To have a whole school healthy schools week (spring 2 2017/2018) to celebrate and showcase the school as a 'healthy school'
