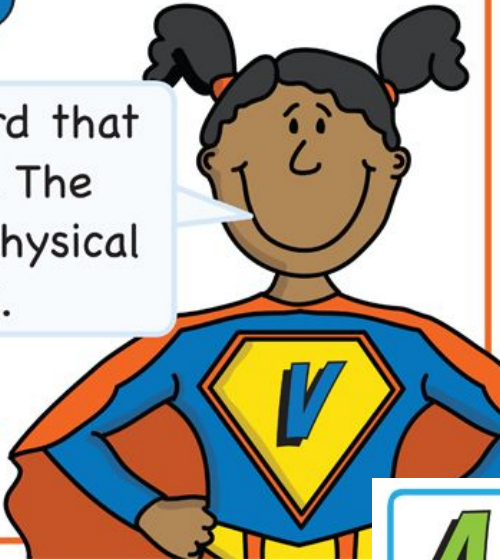
Can I identify nouns, verbs and adjectives?

VERB

A **verb** is a word that shows actions. The action can be physical or mental.

think

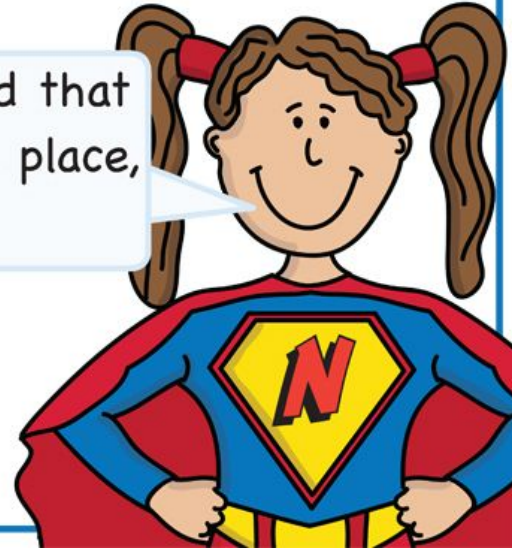


Read the posters to remind yourselves!

NOUN

A **noun** is a word that names a person, place, thing or idea.

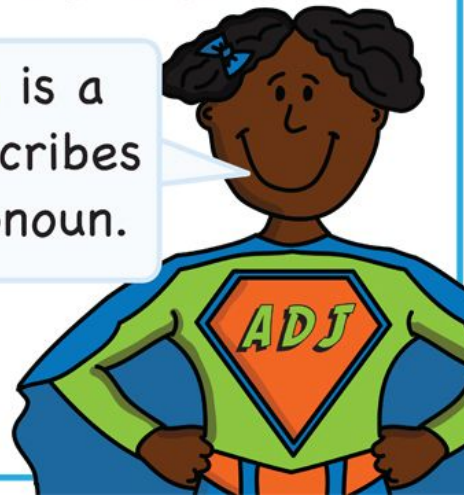
Person : grandma
Place : forest
Thing : wolf
Idea : joy



ADJECTIVE

An **adjective** is a word that describes a noun or pronoun.
