The correct name for speech punctuation is – **inverted commas**.

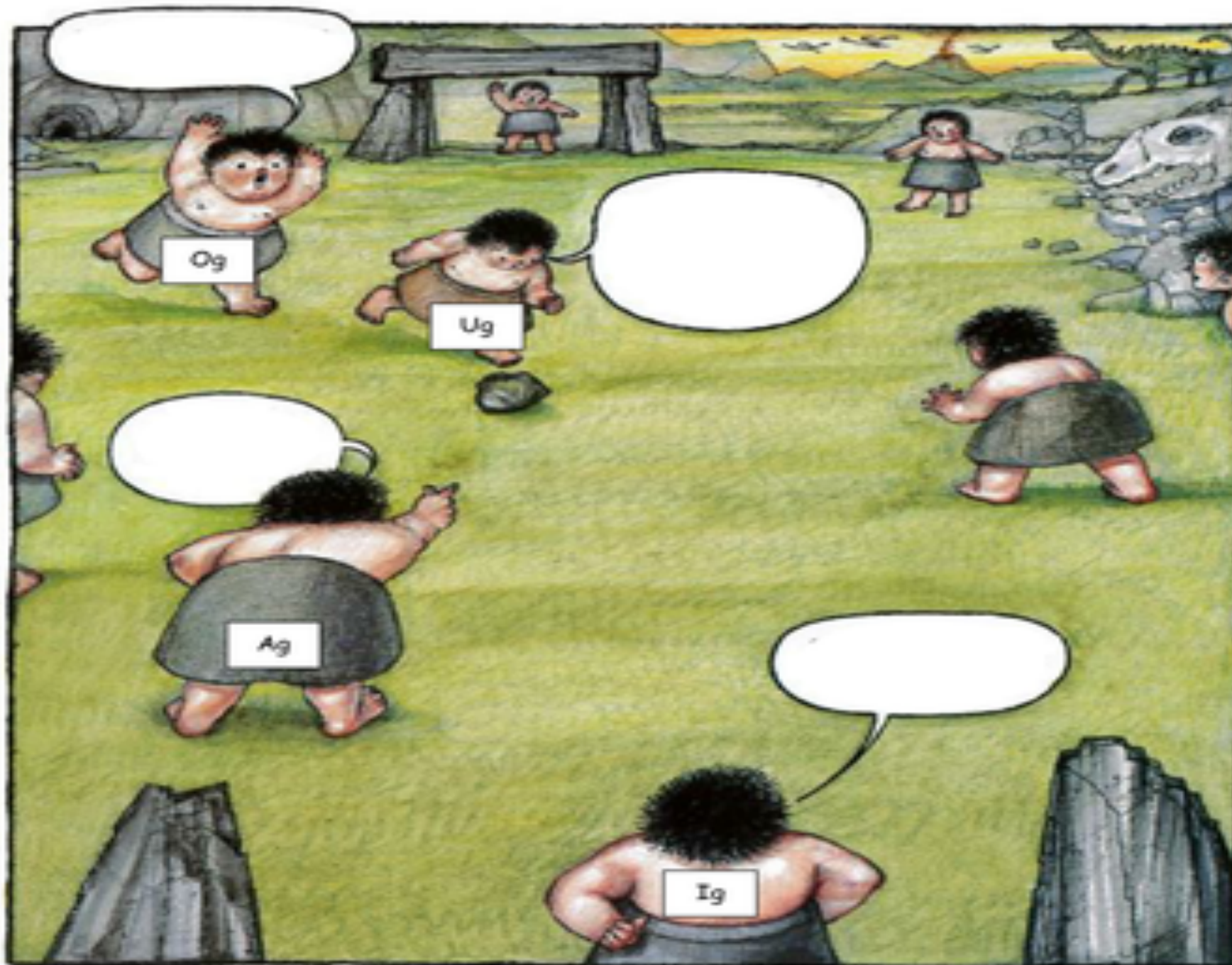

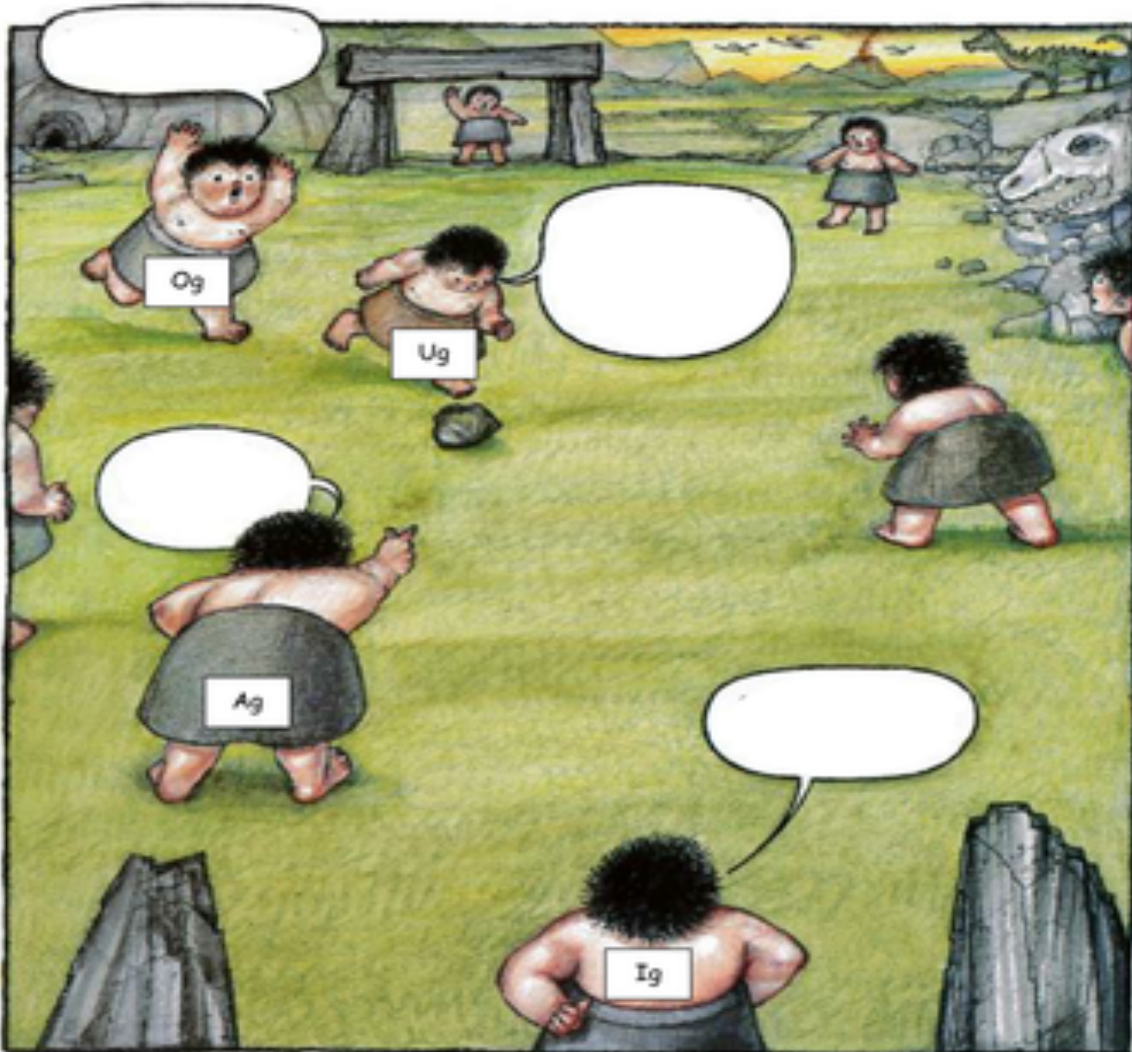


This picture shows the characters Og, Ug, Ag and Ig.
