# Task 2. Write a short character description of Auggie


- Using as many words as you can from your new vocabulary, write a short character description of Auggie. Just describe him.. No action.



The Anglo-Saxons came from <u>Denmark</u>, <u>Germany</u> and the <u>Netherlands</u>.

These fearsome warriors rowed across the n North Sea in wooden boats to England and forced the tribes in Britain to flee their homes.

Within a few centuries, the land they had invaded was known as England, after the Angles.



## But, who were they ..?

- Talk to your partner.
- Who do you think they were?
  - Click ahead to find out!!

- Believe it or not, the Anglo-Saxons were **warrior-farmers.** They began to invade Britain while the <u>Romans</u> were still in control.
- They wanted control and land.
- The Anglo-Saxons were tall, fair-haired men, armed with swords and spears and round shields.
- Their other skills consisted of hunting, farming, textile (cloth) production and leather working.



There were three groups of people who settled in Britain which together, are called the <u>Anglo-Saxons</u>.

These three groups are called:

<u>Jutes</u>

**Angles** 

Saxons

The Angles and the Saxon tribes were the largest of the three attacking tribes and so we often know them as Anglo-Saxons.


