3. Panash thinks he has added an expanded noun phrase to the sentence below.



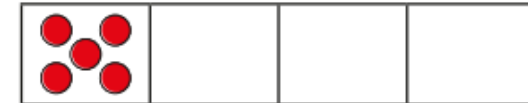
They went to the beach for the day.

- The counters in the bar model show that  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a quantity is 5



Use the bar model to work out the fractions of the same quantity.

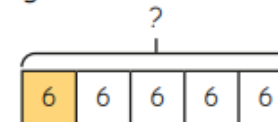
▶  $\frac{2}{4} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

▶  $\frac{3}{4} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

▶  $\frac{4}{4}$  or 1 whole =  $\underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

- Eva uses a bar model to help work out the missing amount.

$\frac{1}{5}$  of  $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 6$



If one part is 6, then all the parts will be 6



$6 \times 5 = 30$       $\frac{1}{5}$  of  $30 = 6$

Use Eva's method to work out the missing amounts.

▶  $\frac{1}{5}$  of  $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 9$

▶  $\frac{1}{7}$  of  $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 10$

▶  $\frac{1}{8}$  of  $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 3$

▶  $\frac{1}{12}$  of  $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 2$
