We have been really fortunate at St Martins to be supported by Nina & Tuesday (Occupational Therapy Students from the University of Derby). They have been working with a range of students across St Martins and Horizons to support with a range of needs; gross motor skills, fine motor skills, independent living skills and community skills.

We have also been working closely with Children's Choice Therapy Service and have a qualified Occupational Therapist working in school once a half term.

Please contact myself or Emma Banks at school if you feel that your child would benefit from support with:

- Fine/Gross Motor Skills
- Independent/Community Skills
- Socialisation
- Sensory Needs/Regulation
- Coping Strategies

We can then discuss further and support through the OTs available in school.
