# **Derby City Council - Home to School Transport**

Derby City Council have published their Home to School Transport newsletter.

Please take some time to read this in case your child/young person is affected by any changes. In particular, there are changes to transport arrangements for students moving to and currently in Post-16 – Derby City Council may no longer arrange taxis or minibuses for students; instead, students eligible for transport may have personal travel budgets instead which can be used to:

- purchase an annual bus pass(es)
- cover or contribute towards fuel costs
- cover or contribute to the cost of a taxi
- cover or contribute towards childcare costs for younger siblings, to allow parents to take their post 16 young person to school or college

There will also be a new Independent Travel Training service to help and support more young people to become independent travellers. This service will be delivered by Transition 2.
