Exciting News! - Funding Update

We have had some amazing news here at Umbrella! Our Lottery funding for our Family Support Service was due to come to an end at the end of October. We have been busy behind the scenes preparing funding applications and we are delighted to say that we have been successful! The National Lottery Community Fund has granted us 3 years of funding. This funding starts on the 1st November 2021. We are absolutely thrilled that we will be able to support so many more families due to this funding and are so grateful to the National Lottery Community Fund for making this happen.

You won't see many changes to our service initially. We will be carrying on providing the same high quality support over the telephone and at in person groups, we will also be continuing to provide our Family Fun activities during school holidays and workshops throughout the year. However, we will be recruiting 2 new team members very soon and early next year we will be launching our new early intervention service for families who are at the very beginning of their journey and need a little bit of extra help and support. Look out for an e-mail about this very soon. We will also be shifting our focus towards carer wellbeing and hopefully providing you with some much needed time for yourselves so watch this space for more announcements about that! The Family support team are absolutely delighted that we will be able to continue working with so many of you and can't wait to see you at groups and activities soon!


