### [Advice for Students and Families](#)

- Consider a range of potential post 16 provisions. Places can be limited and so it is important to have a number of options.
- Contact those provisions you feel are suitable for your child and arrange a visit.
- Start the application process early. Places can be limited so the sooner you can identify a suitable provision the better. During the Year 11 Annual Review Meeting you will be asked to name your choices of post 16 provisions.

# Year 11 Annual Review Meetings

- ⇒ Your child's annual review meeting will take place during the Autumn Term of Year 11. You will receive a letter inviting you to this meeting. We will also invite key school staff and any other professionals who support your child.
- ⇒ Your child will also be given the opportunity to offer their views in this meeting.
- ⇒ During this meeting we will talk about the progress your child has made towards their targets (known as medium term outcomes and long term targets). We will also look at your child's Education Health Care Plan (EHCP) to make sure that the information is up to date.
- ⇒ An important part of this meeting will be a discussion around the post-16 provision choices for your child.

## Pathway to Working Life – The Roundhouse

- ⇒ This course is for students who have additional learning needs.
- ⇒ Places are allocated on an individual basis, following an interview and an initial assessment.
- ⇒ Within this full-time course, learners will work towards achieving a Functional English and Maths qualification and a work skills qualification as well as gaining work skills experience.

## The STEPS Programme– The Roundhouse / Ilkeston

- ⇒ The STEPS programme is designed to develop the skills, attitudes and behaviours a young person needs to progress to their chosen next step.
- ⇒ In addition to improving your maths and English skills, we will work with you to identify other things you may need to develop to be successful in your next step.
- ⇒ There are no formal entry requirements.

- ⇒ Horizons offers positive, progressive pathways for students with learning difficulties and additional needs towards a brighter future.
- ⇒ Students learning is centred around the SHAPE curriculum. A number of accreditations are offered from Entry Level 2 to Level 2.
- ⇒ Every student attends a one day a week offsite placement to enable them to build resilience and work skills as well as providing the opportunity to gain an additional qualification in an area of interest.
- ⇒ Independence is supported and fostered as students grow in confidence and try new experiences.
- ⇒ Horizons will support students to contribute positively in the community as valued citizens.

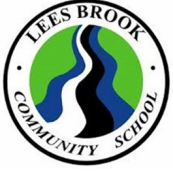




## The Skills Academy

- ⇒ The Skills Academy is part of Lees Brook School. The Skills Academy provides courses for young people aged 16-18 who need a more specialised curriculum.
- ⇒ The Skills Academy concentrates on courses at Entry Level and Level 1 and Level 2 that are mainly vocational (work related).
- ⇒ As well as following a vocational course students are also expected to gain additional qualifications in Functional Skills like English and Maths. Additional support is given where needed.
- ⇒ Students are taught in small teaching groups with the support of tutors and support staff.





## The Skills Academy

The vocational courses you can access are:

- ⇒ Developing Skills for Employment and Work
- ⇒ Hairdressing
- ⇒ Beauty Therapy
- ⇒ Catering
- ⇒ Construction
- ⇒ Health and Social Care.

Facilities: They have a fully equipped hair and beauty salon, catering kitchen and construction centre. They have a modern Astroturf football facility and up to date computer and library areas.

The vocational courses you can access are:

### ⇒ **NVQ Level 1 Hairdressing**

⇒ Level 1 will suit you if you are new to the industry and have little or no experience of hairdressing and barbering. You are looking to be a Hairdressing Assistant.

### ⇒ ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no formal entry requirements for this course but you must be between the ages of 16 – 18, and have an interest in the hair and beauty sector.

⇒ As part of the programme you may be required to complete Functional Maths and English at Level 1. A tutor will support you in this to ensure that you get the best training available.

## ⇒ Confetti—Institute of Creative Technologies

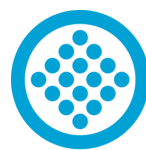
⇒ Confetti is based in the Nottingham city centre.
