What a long and busy term this has been.


In the last two weeks we had three amazing Christmas concerts:

Once you have completed your online application, please collect a Supplementary Information Form (SIF) pack from the school office. When returning your completed (SIF) form please include the following documents:

- · Your child's birth certificate
- Baptism certificate (if applicable)
- Proof of address


