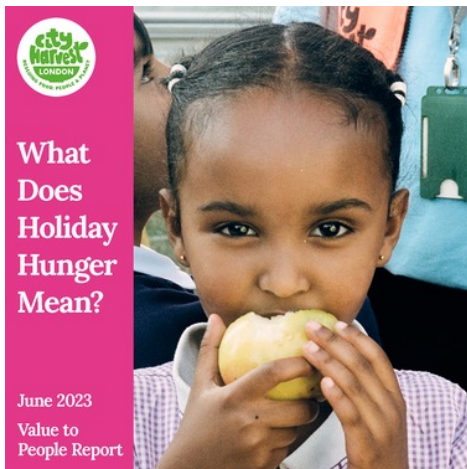
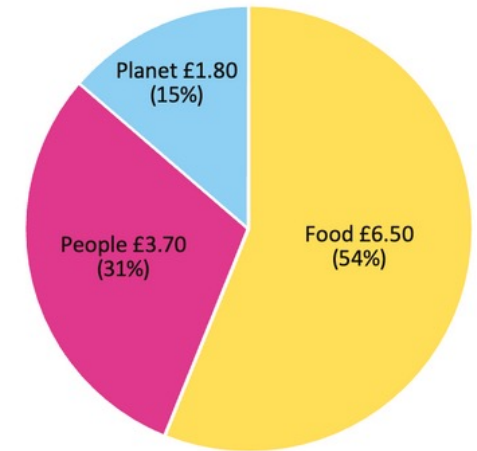

Providing free, healthy food to community partners feeding some of London's most vulnerable residents enables these organisations to stretch their budgets further to offer additional, vital services to those who require them. **For every 1 kg food redistributed, City Harvest delivers an estimated £3.55 of positive impact for food recipients and food donors.**

City Harvest delivers to every kind of community group in London, including food banks, faith groups, community centres, domestic abuse refuges, hostels, shelters, food banks, schools, refugee centres, mental health centres, family centres and youth clubs.

City Harvest's Social Return on Investment

For every £1 invested in City Harvest, **£11.90** of value is created each year for society.
