Attendance

We are working towards achieving 96% attendance this academic year. Please be aware that holiday leave in term time <u>cannot be authorised</u>.

Attendance

Whole school attendance to date stands at 91.2%, which is lower than this time last year.

There is strong correlation between good attendance and good progress. Please make sure your child is at school unless they are unwell.

Punctuality also contributes to attendance so we encourage everyone to be at school for **the soft** start at 8.45am

Absence

In the event of your child being absent, you must let the office know in the morning. It is school policy that you phone the office by 9.15am each day your child is absent, as the school has a legal responsibility and a duty of care to know where your child is between 9am and 3.15pm.

A phone call will be made to parents if an absence is not reported. If we do not receive a reason for an absence, it will automatically be recorded as unauthorised.

All doctor and dentist appointments should be booked outside school hours when possible. The office should be informed in advance when your child has a medical appointment.

Medicines

We are currently updating our records. If your child has an ongoing allergy or medical need, please inform the school. If your child has an allergy that requires an EpiPen or is prescribed an asthma pump, please bring in their Allergy Action Plan or Asthma Plan to the office as soon as possible.

There should be two EpiPens per child in school, that are both in date.
