Your son / daughter has been invited to attend our Post 16 'Sampling Days'. The days will take place at the respective college campuses/training providers on the following dates;

These days offer an opportunity for your child to meet staff and students of the college and experience campus life, as well as finding out what they need to do to pursue their career path of choice.

This year we have made and exciting development to the Careers Inspiration and Guidance programme by personalizing pupils sampling experiences, as far as we possibly can. As our Catholic feeder college and an outstanding college with a wide variety of course options, all pupils will attend Cardinal Newman College on 5th July.
