## Who can apply?

Any parent or carer of a child currently enrolled at the school is eligible to stand for election, unless they are disqualified under the regulations (details available on request).

## How to apply

To this end, the governing board are asking that prospective candidates submit a brief summary (100 words) as to why they feel they are best suited to the role.
