Good Improvements

private organisations are owned or controlled by private individuals or share holders. The function to sell goods and services with the aim of making a profit.

Types of organisation.

voluntary - are independent organisations funded by memberships, donations, grants and sales of products and services. They function to provide a service, support members, promote a cause, education and even sell products and services.

public - are funded and sometimes operated by central and local government. They function to provide a service, regulate, educate or inform.

legacy - money or property left to someone in a will. e.g. a historic house left in someone's will to the National Trust

Examples of travel and Tourism organisations:-

Private - tour operators and travel agents.

Public - tourist information centres, national tourism agencies, museums

voluntary - conservation charities.

Private - Ryan air is a private company in Ireland. This is an airline company aiming to make a private profit therefore it is a private company

Public - national tourist boards such as museums. P You don't have to pay to go to a museum but they are also tourist places e.g. titanic museum.

Voluntary - can include environmental groups such as national trust which do charities that include everyone and make things fun.
