Whilst the same catering team will remain on site, pupils and staff will notice new menus and food choices, which hopefully will be to everyone's satisfaction and taste. As a school, we would welcome any feedback as we look to improve the catering offer to your child.

#### Year 11

On Wednesday, 22 January, we will be holding our Year 11 Progress Evening (3:30-6:30pm). Please do all you can to attend on the night and gain valuable updates on your child's current performance, plus crucial pointers on how they can make further progress in the final months. This evening builds on the recent mock exams that pupils sat. The invigilators were keen to praise the pupils for the way in which they approached the exams and conducted themselves in the exam hall. All mock results will be distributed to pupils on Friday, 10 January.

#### Year 10

The Year 10 post-16 Mock Interviews will be held on Tuesday, 11 February. This is an important event for all the pupils and reminds them that they will be school leavers in just 18 months. Every pupil in Year 10 must have completed a Personal Statement by Friday, 17 January, and returned these to their form tutor. These statements will be sent off to the prospective interviewer in good time before the event, so please encourage your child to have their statement ready upon our return. These mock interviews are an excellent way of preparing for the college or apprenticeship interviews which pupils will be undertaking before they leave school.

In addition, pupils in Year 10 will be taking part in a full week of work experience. This will take place from Monday, 17 March to Friday, 21 March. Pupils are asked to have secured their own suitable placement by Monday, 13 January, but help and advice, if necessary, is available from our Careers Adviser, Mrs McVey; e.mcvey@lsmchs.com
