Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that this letter finds you and all your family well as we approach the May half term. Although things have not quite fully got back to normal, we can certainly see an end in sight to the restrictions which have affected us all in the last 14 months.

Covid-19 Testing

Thankfully, since our return in March, we have had very few positive cases of Covid-19 reported to us, and only one occasion when we have had to ask pupils to isolate in number. However, we know that Covid-19 is still prevalent, especially the new variant and especially in the North West, as seen by the letter we forwarded on this week from the LCC Director of Public Health. Therefore, I ask that you continue to support the home testing programme. Test kits have once again been issued to all pupils and they are still asked to home test twice a week.

Summer Term Expectations

School finishes today for the week-long half term holiday. We reopen on Monday 7 June at 8:45am. When we return, we will, of course, expect the highest standards of uniform and appearance from all our pupils. Unseasonally cool weather has led to a small number of pupils wearing hoodies under their blazers. Hoodies are not part of St Mary's uniform policy, so such items will be confiscated on our return. All pupils have been informed of this.

In addition, I would ask that pupils return with all the correct equipment, including footwear - black trainers, no matter how smart, are not part of St Mary's uniform!

'Everyone's Invited'

As always, informing and communicating the latest safeguarding information is critical to us in ensuring that all children are safe and cared for whilst attending school. I therefore want to highlight the recent 'everyone's invited' campaign. This is an initiative brought about to raise awareness of abuse and in ensuring that all children feel comfortable speaking to an adult in school or having the knowledge of how to report any abuse in education. The NSPCC have now launched a free and anonymous helpline for young people who have experienced abuse at school. It is also accessible to parents and carers who need support and guidance.
